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Uniform Guidelines and General Standards

1. Hair: /2 or RA (Religious accommodation - award max points)

Hair is worn so the cadet's face is visible (/1) and does not prevent the proper wear of headdress or protective equipment (/1)

2. Headdress: /2

Headdress is well kept (i.e lint, stain, thread, wrinkle free, positioned correctly, and sits well)

3. Shirt/Tunic: /5

Shirt/Tunic is well kept (i.e lint, stain, thread, and wrinkle free) and buttoned appropriately. (/3)

Creases (dove tail for tunic) are centred and sharp, Badges are sewn and positioned correctly with name tag, medals, and other merits positioned correctly (/2)

4. Accoutrements: /1

Rings, Necklaces, bracelets, Piercings, Make-up are not distracting and do not inhibit general function/movements

5. Trousers: /5

Belt is worn centred and "brass-on-brass" (/1)

Creases are sharp and centred front and back (/3)

Hemmed evenly to the third eyelet of boots (/1)

6. Boots: /10

Toe: shined to the first major crease line with blackened welts and sole (/4)

Heel and Sides: Evenly polished with blackened welts and sole (/2 + /2)

Laced horizontally and excess laces are tucked away (/2)

692 Standards: Cadets are urged to follow these stricter standards to achieve 3 possible bonus marks

Hair: All conditions met: Yes/No /1

Males: Hair is not touching collar or ears; facial hair is clean-shaven, not UNNATURALLY dyed or styled

Females: Hair is not touching collar, is tied in a tight bun and gelled down (no wispsies), and is not UNNATURALLY dyed

Accoutrements: Both conditions met: Yes/No /1

N/A to all categories, i.e no rings, necklaces, bracelets, piercings, or extravagant make-up

Watch is navy, black, or dark coloured and nondescript, worn on non-dominant wrist, and set to the CORRECT time *
